



Important notes

You must declare your major before registering for your sixth unit of course work. See the Registrar's office or the departmental administrative assistant for the required form.

Within your course work, you must complete a minimum of one unit of each of the following groups:

A: Sciences and Mathematics

NUTR (science minor), Applied Statistics (see MATH), BIOL, CHEM, CMPS, MATH, PHYS, PSYC
MATH 2208 & 2209 are recommended.

B: Social Sciences (completed via SOAN major)

C: Humanities

CHIN, CULS, ENGL, FREN, HIST, LIBR, PHIL, RELS, SPAN, WRIT

You may count up to four units of professional study towards your major. Professional study subjects include:

BUSI, CHYS*, INTE, NUTR (professional minor), PBRL, THMT

*Practica may not be counted for credit towards the degree (i.e. CHYS 2251, 3351, 3352, 4451)

You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of SOAN as general electives, if you wish.

Students may count a maximum of 4.0 units of directed/independent/research studies courses towards the degree, with no more than 2.0 units in any single discipline.

A minimum of 9.0 units of your degree must be at the 2000 level or above. Of the 9.0, at least 3.0 units of SOAN at the 2000 level (SOAN 2500, 2510, and 2.0 units of electives) and 2.0 units of SOAN at the 3000 level or above (SOAN 3501, 3511, 3512, and 0.5 units SOAN electives) are required.

At least 5.0 units of the 12.0 units overall completed for combined majors must be at the 3000 level or above.

Up to half of your major and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit (including Authorized External Courses). Courses with a "P" grade are GPA neutral.

Your GPA in both majors must be ≥ 2.0 . Your overall GPA must be ≥ 1.70 . See the academic calendar for more information.

You may complete a minor as part of your general electives credit. Standard minor requirements (i.e. 3.0 units as per the minor department, 2.0 GPA) apply.

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount.

However, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
